I. Adolescent Health Care EXAMPLES: Normal physical growth and development, Psychosocial development, Physical exam, Nutrition, Legal issues	12%
II. Behavioral Sciences EXAMPLES: Drug use/abuse, Psychosocial problems, Rape	10%
III. Cardiovascular Problems EXAMPLES: Cardio risk factors, Hypertension, Murmurs, Mitral valve prolapse	6%
IV. Dermatological Problems	10%
V. Eating Disorders EXAMPLES: Anorexia nervosa and bulimia, Obesity	10%
VI. Endocrine Problems EXAMPLES: Abnormal growth and development, Thyroid disease, Gynecomastia	8%
VII. Genitourinary Disorders	8%
VIII. Infectious Diseases EXAMPLES: Mononucleosis, Hepatitis, HIV/AIDS	10%
IX. Neurological Disorders EXAMPLES: Headaches, Sleep disorders, Epilepsy	8%
X. Orthopedic Problems EXAMPLES: Back pain, Scoliosis and Kyphosis, Sports medicine	8%
